Overall the weather and water conditions improved as the week progressed especially on the Bell Irving. The Nass fished good all week and this fact once again shows the benefits of booking some helifishing days during your stay with us.

The top rod for the week was Torsten Olsdotter from Sweden. Torsten hooked over 30 steelhead during his stay and landed a number of fish in the 15 lb range. It was our pleasure to host two fine gentleman from the UK - Ian & Simon proved that persistence and perseverance along with your most "favoured" techniques are all required to land BC steelhead. Thank you for your stories and good humour gents.

Rick Rouse had the fish of the season. A beautiful 19 lb hen (pictured) landed with a single handed rod on the Nass was as perfect a steelhead as you could ever envision. Almost chrome bright and unmarked from her journey, she was hooked at the very end of the day on one of his last casts. Mike and Tyler also hooked and landed their first steelhead ever this week.

We had a special opportunity to host a group of anglers from the Vancouver Club for 2 days. Organizer Rob Williams assembled a super gang of guys ranging in ability from "been there and done that" to just "picked up a fly rod". It was fun anyway you look at it. Top rod in this group was Jason Mclean - who, although only learning to fly fish, hooked 5 cohos, 2 steelhead and a couple of trout in the two days he fished. We also had the privilege of witnessing an "almost" triple header for steelies on the Nass. With one fish just released (Rob with 10 pound hen), both Gord and Roger hooked up. Two fish landed - 17 pound hen and 15 pound bright buck. One of the highlights of the season for sure.
