



Fishing Report for week of 19-26 September, 2004

Weather: Hi 15C; Lo 0C. Cloudy with rain. Sunny breaks at end of the week.

Conditions were prime to start the week. The first day of the season was spent on the Bell Irving River. We hooked and landed a number of fresh steelhead. These fish were bright, aggressive and HOT. A great way to start the season! And then the rains came.....

We are lucky enough to have access to 5 or 6 different rivers. Some of these rivers are fed by headwater lakes and continue to run clean even after the heaviest rain. We fished two of these locations for the next five days. We were able access clean rivers on the upper Nass by helicopter and on the lower Nass by truck and jet boat. We landed steelhead each day this week.

Highlights of the week included Nico's 6 hook up day, Julian's 19 pound buck and Dr John's great sense of humour and even more importantly his patience.
