



Fishing Report for week of 26 September to 03 October, 2004

Weather: Hi 18C; Lo 3C. Beautiful sunshine

After a week of rain, most rivers were still running a bit high to start the week. The forecast was for cool nights and clear days which in turn would bring our rivers back in shape. We three guests from the USA with us for the first time. The guinea pigs (so to speak) on our first ever "Upper Nass package". Our guests had two days of fishing the Nass, two days and nights on the Damdochax River with Alice and Hannah Belford and two days of fishing on the Bell Irving River. Most locations are only accessible by helicopter.

The week started fast. Bill landed 3 steelies on the first day and never looked back. Bill lost count of his hook-ups around mid week and after that it was all about the experience. Bob was a very experienced fly fisher that had spent many years in Alaska. He has little trouble hooking and landing fish on days this week. Dave had a memorable day later in the week landing three steelhead in one afternoon.
