

Fishing Report for week of 26 September to 03 October, 2005

Weather: Hi 10; Lo -2C. Cool, wet weather. Rain and snow to start the week. Unsettled weather

Rivers fished: Bell Irving, Nass, Damdochax, Cranberry, Kiteen, Meziadin,

Guests from the United States and Italy this week with all guests booking our Combination package with the Damdochax River Lodge. The report below will summarize the fishing on all rivers except the Damdochax. Fishing conditions from this week on the Damdochax can be found on www.damdochax.com

The water conditions on the Bell Irving were in very good shape to start the week. Rain and snow brought river levels up for two days but cold weather made for a quick recovery and good fishing by weeks end. Overall, the Bell Irving was fishing consistently and averaging a fish per day per rod with more fish hooked and lost each day.

The Nass was more affected by the rain and was marginally fishable during most of this week. We suspected that fresh fish were on their way and the Nass was going to turn on when water levels dropped. Read next week's report to find out ☺

The Meziadin was now producing more steelhead and the Coho fishing was reaching it's peak. Coho's could now almost be caught at will providing some super action on light fly gear.

Overall, a slower week due to water conditions with 24 steelhead hooked for 24 rod days. Numerous Coho and trout were caught. Reports from the Damdochax River are not included in these catch figures.
