

Fishing Report for week of 14-21 September, 2007

Weather: Hi 17C; Lo -3C. Some beautiful sunny days with cool night time temperatures. Some unsettled weather later in the week.

The week started with “improving” water conditions. We had landed a couple of good steelhead the week previous and were hoping that the fish would be showing up in decent numbers during this week. We had 3 very capable anglers from Germany and Austria and a helicopter to explore.

The fishing on the Bell Irving was good for Coho this week. We had a number of 10 plus fish days when targeting Coho. The Bull trout fishing was also very good. The steelhead fishing was slow. We were able to land a few fish but not in the numbers that we are used too.

The Nass River which is typically a very consistent system in mid September was in great shape. Due to the incredible snowpack this area received last winter, the powerful spring floods changed many of the pools and completely altered the course of this wild river. The first week was spent fishing new water and pools everyday while trying to explore as much of the “new” river as we could.

After guiding this river for 5 years we were amazed at the changes that could be possible. Many of the pools fished better than ever and others were simply not there anymore. Even with a lack of fish in the system early in the season we were excited for the days ahead on this new water.
