

Fishing Report for week of 21-28 September, 2007

Weather: Hi 10C; Lo -3C. Rainy days with cool temps. Steelhead weather!

The crew from the UK was back. With 9 years of combined experience on the Nass system, if anyone could catch steelhead these guys can.....and did. Although the weather was typical for this time of year, the water conditions remained stable to allow fishing on the Nass and Bell every day. We fished in groups of 2 anglers and a guide to maximize the variety of water we were able to cover. We did not catch the number of fish that we usually do for this time of the year but our most experienced steelhead anglers were able to hook a fish everyday during this week.

We were starting to pick up fish in the new runs on the Nass. What a beautiful float this has become – pool after pool of holding water so good you can't pass up any of it. As usual, no one within miles.

We hooked 12 steelhead this week and numerous Coho, Bull trout and rainbows. Overall a challenging week for our new and returning guests.
