

Fishing Report for week of 28 September to 05 October, 2007

Weather: Hi 8C; Lo -4C. Cloudy days with cool temps. Some rainfall

Rivers: Bell Irving, Nass, Damdochax river and lake

Weather and water conditions have been good. Most anglers are experienced or returning. The fishing has been slower this season. Although we have had some bright days overall we are still working for every fish.

The Bell Irving River produced 15 steelhead this week and still some good Coho fishing. Well below normal catch rates but some solid battles and great stories. A couple of two fish days for 5 time guest Nico Rogerson.

The fishing on the Nass was similar. We did land the largest steelhead of the year and quite possibly the largest steelhead ever at Bell 2 Lodge. The lucky angler was Mike "Hollywood" Lofthus. His first steelhead ever on a single handed 8 weight!!! 41" x 21.5". 14 fish on the Nass this week and most were 15 plus pounds. Goes to show that even in the tough times it's always worth it to go fishing.
