

Fishing Report for week of 2nd to 9th October, 2009

Guests: Axel Wimmer, Roger Urwin

Weather: Hi 11C; Lo -4C. Cloud and sun. Cold night time temperatures.

Axel was back on his usual week. He had decided to book the whole week in 2009 and go helicopter fishing everyday. This works great as he is training to be a pilot and we were able to use the dual controls. This allowed Axel to count his flight hours on his license and get some fishing in as well.

The rivers were in prime shape and the fish were definitely around this year. We had numerous option to explore and the mission was to scout some new rivers and runs to expand our range of rivers in future. We were able to fish the Nass both upper and lower, Talhtan, Shesley, Nahlin, Muskaboo. We found steelhead at almost all locations.

The Nass really was incredible this week. We found fish in the lower river in new water previously not fished. The Nass system is so large you could spend years exploring new places. It's great to have guests who wish to do this on a regular basis.

We found fish in the usual haunts in the upper river and Muskaboo creek. One large buck measured 43x21". This fish bettered Axel's fish from last year of 41x20.5". There were some big fish around this year!!

We had excellent fishing on the Talhtan River and will definitely be expanding the program to include this river in the future. The Shesley and Nahlin rivers were coloured due to a localized rain storm but looked great for future exploration.

Roger Urwin joined us mid week to fish the Bell Irving. This river was in great shape and Roger had 3 fish each day as he was warming p for his helicopter fishing days on the weekend.

Axel finished the week with 28 steelhead landed in 8 days and a few lost. It was some great catching.
