

Fishing Report for week of 25 September to 02 October, 2009

Guests: Nico Rogerson, Ruaridh and Angus Nicoll

Weather: Hi 11C; Lo -4C. Cloud and sun. Cold night time temperatures.

The rain stopped and the temperature fell. Just what the steelhead doctor ordered for the arrival of 7 time guest Nico. Nico was joined by 2 Irish anglers that decided to take advantage of the great run of Nass fish and book a trip at the last minute. All 3 rods were in for a treat as the rivers cleared and the fish were HOT.

We fished the Damdochax for the first two days landing 8 fish. This river was dropping quickly and clearing fast. The Bell and then the Nass would follow suit.

The Bell Irving had a bump of fresh fish. Nico had a taste of this as a chrome hen took him 150' down river cartwheeling into his backing. The average size on the Bell was about 10 pounds and a number of 35-38" fish were landed. All rods landed multiple fish on the Bell this week.

The Nass was really starting to get good later in the week. The higher water takes longer to come down in this massive watershed and the fish were starting to stack up as the river cleared. Having 5 fish days per rod became the normal routine.

Nico finished the week with 15 steelhead. Both Rory and Angus had 10+. There were lots of lost fish as the takes and fight aggressive. We hooked 52 fish for 21 rod days. We will look forward to seeing the guys again next year.
